The Olabisi Onabanjo University Teaching Hospital (OOUTH), Sagamu, Ogun State, hereby invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from qualified, competent, and reputable organizations to manage and operate the Sulaiman Adebola Adegunwa Trauma Centre, a state-of-the-art trauma and emergency care facility located within the hospital premises.

Background

The Sulaiman Adebola Adegunwa Trauma Centre is a modern, purpose-built facility established to provide comprehensive trauma and emergency medical services to Ogun State and its environs. The Centre is equipped with advanced diagnostic, surgical, critical care, and resuscitation facilities and is intended to function as a regional referral hub for trauma care.
